
















Tenant Finish Out General Contractor's Office Austin, Texas

The client wanted open offices, privacy dedicated to a couple of specific rooms, controlled access at the entry, and a character which said "we're not your average general contractor" – all within a modest budget. Attention was given to very specific relationships between rooms, controlling sight lines which were desirable, and undesirable.
